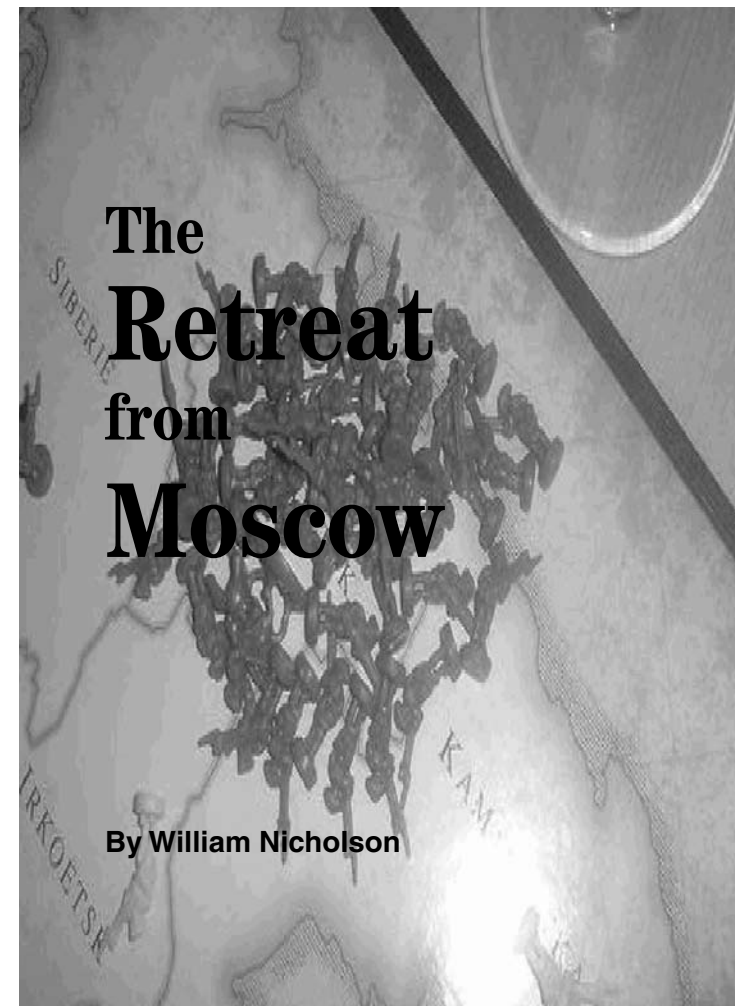

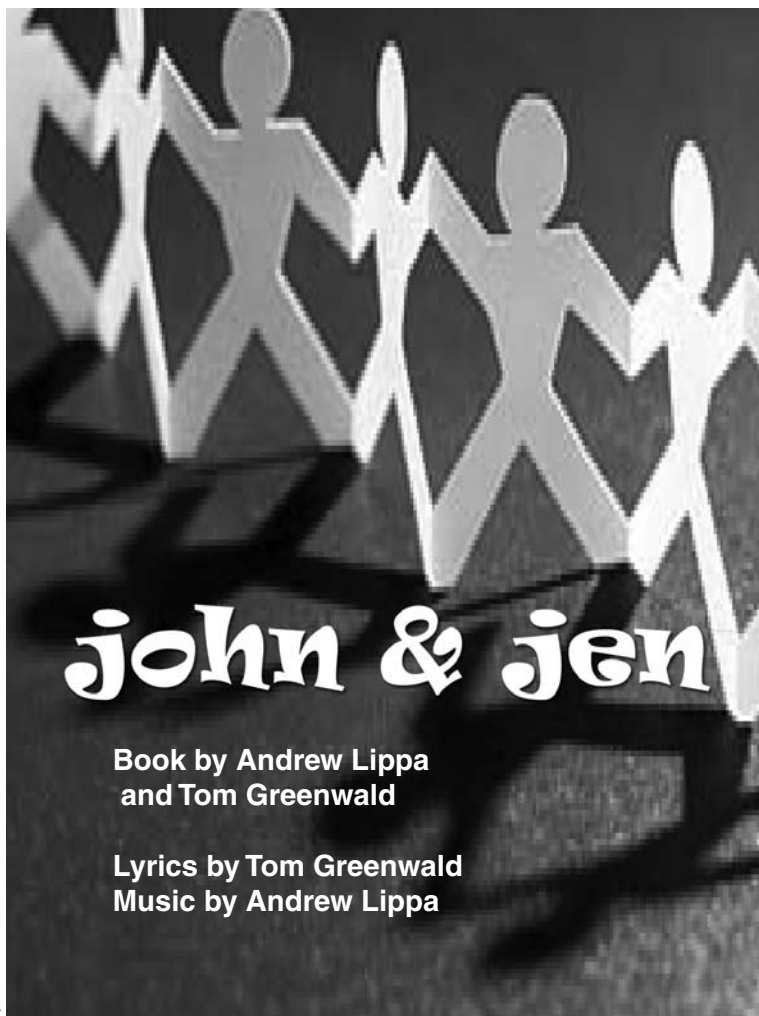

All evening shows are at 8:00 PM. All matinee shows are at 2:00 PM. Doors open 20 minutes prior to curtain. Latecomers may have to wait to be seated until an appropriate break in the performance.

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Standing O reserves the right to change season offerings if necessary with no prior notice. Subscribers may exchange their tickets subject to availability for desired show, a minimum of 24 hours before scheduled performance. Tickets ordered after mailing deadline will be held for patrons at the box office until show time. Tickets will be mailed two weeks prior to performances (\$1.00 handling fee). Standing O does not issue refunds under any circumstances. All sales are final.

Single tickets may be purchased in person, by mail, or by phone. Tickets ordered by phone must be purchased using MasterCard or Visa. Credit cards, checks and cash are accepted by mail or in person. All single ticket sales are final. Standby tickets are sold 30 minutes prior to performance time in person, on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Wheelchair space is available at most performances with advance notice. Please call the Box Office at 410-647-8412 at least one day before scheduled performance and leave a message. Gift certificates for tickets are available.

Directions to Pascal Center (On The Twentieth Century)

From Severna Park, Baltimore, and points North:
 Take Rt. 2 South. Make a left onto College Parkway. Make 1st Right up ramp into Anne Arundel Community College. Stay straight through stop sign. Pascal Center is on the left just past the Cafeteria. Parking Lot across the street from Pascal Center.

From Annapolis and points South:
 Take Rt. 50 East to Rt. 2 North. Make a right onto College Parkway and follow directions above from that point...

Directions to Chesapeake Academy (John & jen/The Retreat...)

From Severna Park, Baltimore, and points North:
 Take Rt. 2 South. Turn right at Jones Station Rd. Turn left onto B&A Blvd. Follow B&A Blvd. for about 1.5 miles. School is on left. Pass school and enter through second entrance. Theatre is in the front right of the building.

 Take Rt. 2 North. Turn left at Jones Station Rd. and follow directions above.
